- The Homeless Hub was opened in February 2019 in Waterford City
- It is an Integrated Service developed in partnership between Waterford Council, the Health Service Executive, Focus Ireland and Southeast Simon Community.
- It's located in the city (bus route) in a former Bank of Ireland premises at 28 Parnell Street
- It is a 'one-stop- shop' of agencies providing a range of services to those experiencing or at risk of homelessness.











Background:

- We were conscious that we were spread throughout various parts of the city.
- We wanted a one-stop-shop, where people can come into one place, tell their story only once and have access to all the services they need.
- People no longer need to go to the council's customer service desk to get help.
- During 2019 we had over 800 people presenting to the Councils offices as homeless.
 That footfall was transferred to a designated service at 28 Parnell Street.
